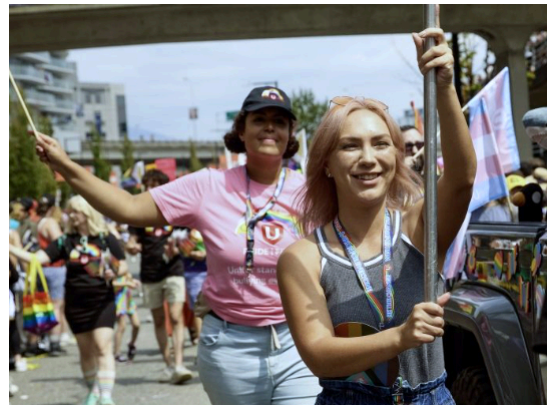

Unifor members took over downtown Toronto for a massive march and rally for public health care.

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Unifor is pushing back after Ottawa ordered the CRTC to reconsider its Online Streaming Act implementation decisions.

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The federal government's forestry sector task force proposals provide a clear road map to re-build the sector and create good jobs.

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Unifor urged the government to protect Canadian jobs during the federal budget consultation process.

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An independent mediator has found that Amazon was responsible for the breakdown of first-contract bargaining at its facility in Delta B.C.

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Local 333-BC members at BC Transit in Victoria vote 97% in favour of strike action.

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Local 4276 has served notice of a strike deadline of June 6 at the Fairmont Empress Hotel.

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Members at Bell Technical Solutions in Ontario and Quebec voted to ratify their new collective agreements over the weekend.

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
