Security Clearance Check

Recently managers have been circulating a Police Clearance Consent Form and telling techs they must sign it in order to perform their duties as technicians. As a current employee of Bell you are not obligated to sign a Police consent form. Nowhere in the Collective Agreement does it state that techs must have a security and/or credit check to perform their job. This is a request for new hires only. This clearance consent form not only violates the Collective Agreement, but is in breech of Bill C-6 which is the Privacy Act. This can be brought forward to the Privacy Commission and Bell could potentially be brought up on charges. We are advising our membership that they do <u>not</u> have to sign any such consent forms.
